

School Attendance Matters



They meet weekly and do everything possible to ensure that our students are supported in the very best ways possible with their learning and wellbeing. Step 6 – Learning and Support Team

Learning Support Team discuss referral and determine appropriate action. Personalised Learning and Support Plan (PLASP) may be created in consultation with class teacher. Review date set. Parents informed. Support may include:

- Counsellor (Counsellor Referral required).
- Teacher mentoring
- LaST
- Data Collection-FBA
- Application for funding (SES or ACCESS REQUEST)
- Outside provider recommended (paediatrician, speech pathologist)

Step 7 – Implement/Monitor

Recommendations or PLASP is implemented and monitored by classroom teacher, AP and Learning and Support Team.

Step 8a If learning /behavioural outcomes improve, assistance may be phased out.

Step 8b

If learning/behaviour outcomes have not improved, plans are modified in consultation with Learning and Support Team. We hope that parents and carers find this all other sources of student data.

NAPLAN

This week saw the commencement of NAPLAN for students in Years 3 & 5. As in 2019, the tests are mostly completed online. The online platform does enable the questions to be more suited to the students' ability levels and knowledge, so it will provide us with very valuable information. We want all our Year 3 and 5 students to be positive and calm when they sit the tests so that they can do their very best. It is important not to place too much importance on NAPLAN for students as this can cause pressure, stress and anxiety. NAPLAN is a 'point in time' assessment of Literacy and Numeracy, it is one of many assessments that our students undertake throughout a school year and is never considered in isolation to

Don't be a stranger!

Talk to your child's teacher early and when barnier-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au

Emails will be forwarded by our office staff to teachers at the first opportunity. Teachers will then phone parents asap to chat or organise an interview time.

Sometimes responses may take a little time as teachers are busy teaching, attending meetings, doing playground duties, counselling students who are experiencing challenges and participating in professional learning after school hours as well as making sure they get adequate break times themselves within the school day. Please be reassured that we have received your email and we will respond as soon as we can.

Positive Behaviour for Learning

Our PBL initiatives are up and running again following the challenges of Covid last year which were very disruptive to this program. Our core values are: Respect, Responsibility and Resilience. We have a very passionate committee who are leading this across the school. They are looking at implementing a school wide resilience program for our students. The team will also create lesson plans for teachers on our PBL expectations for behaviour and learning that will be based on student data.

Learning doesn't stop at 2:45pm.

You can help the teacher do a better job by encouraging your children to show you something they are working on at school. Every time your children get a chance to show off what they know, it builds confidence.

Let your child make mistakes.

Teachers don't want perfect students; they want students who try their best and confidently take risks with their learning. Sometimes parents think every assignment or homework task has to be done exactly right, and they can put too much pressure on their children. It's OK for children to get some problems wrong. Children learn by making mistakes. It's important for teachers to see what students don't know, so they can further support their learning at school.

Teachers are on your side.

Some parents go into attack mode when their child complains about a teacher or they take the problem to the principal. Timely, open and honest communication with your child's teacher can usually sort things out before issues escalate and help build great relationships and better understandings.

Our Teachers work hard

Teaching isn't easy so it's incredibly uplifting when someone takes the time to say thank you. Why not email when your child enjoys a class event or learning activity? If you feel the teacher is doing a good job, let them and the principal know. Teachers deserve to be respected, appreciated, valued, acknowledged and cared about.
