Message from The Principal

This week is Bullying No Way: National week of action.

The theme for 2025 is 'Be bold. Be kind. Speak up.'

Throughout this week, students will engage in explicit lessons about what bullying is and how we can all contribute to its prevention. On Wednesday, students are invited to wear purple accessories as a sign of support against bullying.
