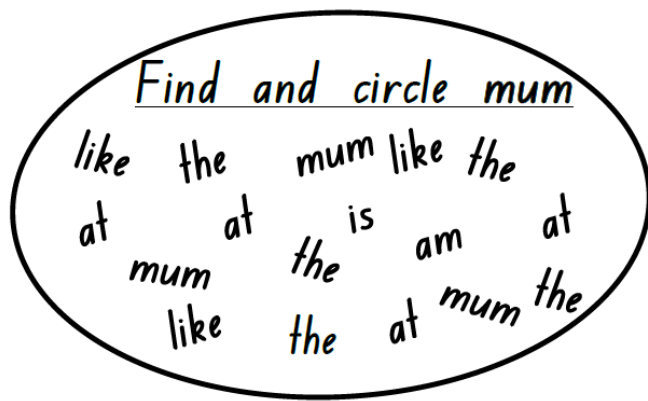


Read the home reader every night.

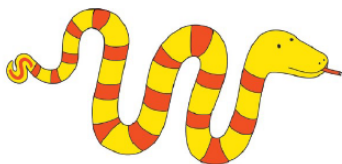
Record it once on the reading log.

Sally the snake's name begins with the sound / s /. The first step in learning to read is hearing the sound. Talk to your child about Sally the snake. Talking and reading with your child are very special times. Read a story to your child every day. Encourage your child to be aware of the letters on the page. Point to the letter **s**, and ask, 'What sound does it say?' Do this two or three times, with the letters **m** and **s**. Make it short and fun.
